

2022 ANNUAL REPORT

Awake Ministries provides a faith-based path of empowerment to individuals through addiction recovery, food distribution, and workforce development.

Year in Review

- Awake Ministries provided long-term residential recovery to 57 men and women during the year.
- Awake Ministries hosted 50 Community Celebrate Recovery meetings onsite with an average attendance of 50 people.
- Awake Ministries helped place 21 clients into new full time employment opportunities.
- Awake Ministries distributed food assistance to an average of 8,500 people per month through the Awake Food Bank.
- Awake Ministries supplemented weekend food to 425 identified school children through the Backpack Program.
- Awake had ongoing monthly financial support from 16 local churches. Our ministry also partnered with another 21 churches on various levels and collaborated with 19 local organizations.
- Awake Ministries had 130 active volunteers who served at least once per month.
- Awake supported 67 people to grow in their faith through 1 on 1 discipleship.

In 2022, Awake Ministries operated at capacity in our men's and women's residential recovery facilities. We continued on our path to empowering residents in the areas of spirituality, adult education, and community service.

Our food bank continued to operate as the largest of its kind in the region, declaring war on food insecurity. Through this program, we were able to meet the needs of our community's individuals, families, seniors, veterans, and school children.

In an effort to expand our enterprise/ vocational training and to raise greater community awareness about our organization, Awake Ministries purchased The Paddock coffee shop in December 2022.
